The Engadine West PS Training Band began their musical journey in Term 1 with no prior musical experience and have grown into a confident group of young musicians. They have performed a number of times throughout this year at Education Week Open Day, Frank Vickery Village and performed a wonderful concert for Stage 2 and 3 to encourage them to join the band next year. In Term 3 Engadine West PS hosted the Engadine Music BandTastic event which our Training Band attended. BandTastic is an intensive 1 day workshop for beginning musicians which saw a massed band of 130 students learn and perform new music all while having a great time, the sound was amazing.



Musically depicting a meteor event that occurs in the Earth's atmosphere each day, Fire's Edge is an energetic piece featuring body percussion and dramatic playing. The brighter the meteor, the more rare the event.

Their second piece is a classic song made famous by The Beach Boys and arranged by Michael Sweeney, you will be sure to recognise Surfin' USA.
